**THE FOLLOWING ARE 1 DAY
CLASSES:**

**1) FRIDAY NIGHT 6:00 – 10:00PM
HAZ – MAT ERG**

This is a 4 hour class on the proper use of the DOT's Emergency Response Guidebook. You will learn the importance of each section & how they operate.

**2) FRIDAY NIGHT 6:00 – 10:00 PM
WILDLAND FIREFIGHTING
AWARENESS**

This course is a product of portions from the S – 130 (basic wildland firefighting) & S – 190 (wildland fire behavior) courses. The Kentucky Fire Commission adopted this course for basic firefighting knowledge & is MANDATORY for all new firefighters after 07/01/01.

3) FIREFIGHTER SURVIVAL

SATURDAY ONLY

This course will emphasize removal of trapped or unconscious firefighters from a burning building and

self rescue techniques when the primary escape route is blocked. This is a required course for a new firefighters effective 07/01/00.

**FULL TURNOUT GEAR & SCBA ARE
REQUIRED**

4) INSTRUCTOR'S UPDATE

SATURDAY ONLY

This course meets the requirements set forth by Ky Fire Commission that every instructor must have 8 hours of method instruction update or take a Train – the – Trainer every 3 years to keep their instructors credentials

**5) EMERGENCY TRAFFIC CONTROL &
HIGHWAY CRASH SITE MANAGEMENT**

SATURDAY ONLY

This course combines 2 classes into 1 to enhance the responders safety by establishing guidelines for traffic control & safe traffic flow through an incident.

It's designed to bring all major players together & help them understand the importance of a unified, coordinated effort when managing & clearing a highway crash

6) FIREFIGHTER RESCUE

SUNDAY ONLY

This course is designed to teach us how to rescue victims from a burning building. Special techniques are used for rescue, OSHA 2 in 2 out regulation. This is a required class set forth by Ky. Fire Commission.

REQUIRED**

**7) EMERGENCY SERVICE TRAILER
OPERATIONS & SAFETY PROGRAM**

SUNDAY ONLY

A brand NEW class first time every offered at this school. A VFIS program, that was developed to teach emergency vehicle operators the proper techniques & proper procedures for towing a trailer.

CLASS IS LIMITED TO 20 STUDENTS

**STUDENTS MUST PROVIDE THEIR OWN
HAUL VEHICLE & TRAILER**

8) THERMAL IMAGING OPERATION

SUNDAY ONLY

First time offered in our area. This course will assist you in examining your current practices & help you identify ways to improve those practices. An in – depth look at how thermal imagers can assist in various firefighter application such as, fire attack,

interior search & rescue, urban search & rescue and many more.

THE FOLLOWING ARE 2 DAY CLASSES:

9) BASIC ESSENTIALS OF FIREFIGHTING

This course is for the new firefighter to get 16 hrs. of the recommended 20 hrs. from the Fire Commission, to respond to calls

FULL TURNOUT GEAR & S.C.B.A. ARE REQUIRED

10) CLUSTER “ HARD TO GET HOURS”

This course will feature topics that are always hard to get including but not limited to: Aircraft Crash Fire Rescue, Haz-Mat, Ropes & Knots, Public Education, Alarms & Communication, Emergency & Disaster Training

11) STRATEGY & TACTICS for INITIAL COMPANY OFFICER (STICO)

This NFA course is designed to meet the needs of the Company Officer responsible for managing the operations of one or more companies during structural firefighting operations. STICO is designed to develop the management skills needed by company officers to accomplish assigned tactics at structure fire.

12) ATV SAFETY & RESCUE

Topics include protective gear, main ATV parts & safety features, pre-ride inspection, operating safety, riding skills, riding on slopes & other terrain, first aid & emergency situations.

This is a HANDS - ON class.

STUDENTS MUST PROVIDE THEIR OWN ATV, SAFETY GLASSES, GLOVES, BOOTS & APPROVED HELMET

JUMPSUITS, OR TURNOUT GEAR REQUIRED for RESCUE PORTION

13) AERIAL OPERATIONS

This course will cover proper placement of your apparatus based on terrain, location, & tactical task that is to be performed. Hands on training will be done on set up, positioning for different tactics.

TURNOUT GEAR REQUIRED

14) EMT CON-ED

This course will offer the 16 hours that are mandatory for EMT'S & 1ST Responders to have for re-certification by KBEMS. This class will be a combination of lecture & hands on skills .

15) PROPANE EMERGENCIES

This is a “ LIVE FIRE, HANDS – ON both days. The class will be both residential and bobtail delivery propane class.

FULL TURNOUT GEAR ,S C B A & SPARE CYLINDER

NO BEARDS OR GOTEES PERMITTED FOR LIVE FIRE TRAINING

JUNIOR FIREFIGHTERS ALLOWED IN ALL CLASS EXCEPT AERIAL OPS. & PROPANE EMERGENCIES. MUST BRING SIGNED FIRE COMMISSION RELEASE FORM
