THE FOLLOWING ARE 1DAY CLASSES:

1) FRIDAY NIGHT 6:00 – 10:00PM LEADERSHIP FOR THE NEW COMPANY OFFICER:

This class is for the new fire dept. officer or someone that is looking at becoming an officer. The class will cover the traits of a good officer & the different types of officers in the fire service. 1st TIME OFFERED IN OUR AREA

2) FRIDAY NIGHT 6:00 – 10:00 PM WILDLAND FIREFIGHTING AWARENESS:

This course is a product of portions from the S – 130 (basic wildland firefighting) & S – 190 (wildland fire behavior) courses. The Kentucky Fire Commission adopted this course for basic firefighting knowledge & is MANDATORY for all new firefighters after 07/01/01. (FC 30000)

3) FRIDAY NIGHT 6:00 – 10:00 PM HAZ – MAT AWARENESS:

This class WILL START Friday night & finishes Saturday before lunch . This class will teach 1st responders the needed information to recognize & identify hazardous materials. This class meets the Ky Fire Commission requirements for T-0001

4) FIREFIGHTER SURVIVAL: SATURDAY ONLY

<u>CLASS LOCATION PAINTSVILLE STATION I</u> This course will emphasize removal of trapped or unconscious firefighters from a burning building and self rescue techniques when the primary escape route is blocked. This is a required course for a new firefighters effective 07/01/00. <u>FULL TURNOUT GEAR & SCBA ARE</u> <u>REQUIRED (</u>FC 10000)

5) FIREFIGHTER RESCUE: SUNDAY ONLY

<u>CLASS LOCATION PAINTSVILLE STATION I</u> This course is designed to teach us how to rescue victims from a burning building. Special techniques are used for rescue, OSHA 2 in 2 out regulation. This is a required course for all new firefighters effective 07/01/01

<u>FULL TURNOUT GEAR & SCBA ARE</u> <u>REQUIRED (</u>FC 20000)

6) DRIVERS TRAINING: SATURDAY ONLY

This course will cover Kentucky Laws, driving, responding in personal vehicles & positioning our apparatus. Students will drive the cone course. It's each departments responsibility to make sure their students have apparatus to drive

7) 1st AID, CPR/AED: SUNDAY ONLY

This class will meet the NEW training requirements set forth by Ky. Fire Commission (P 0001 & P0002) for 150 hr & 400 hr certification. At the end of the class students will have the opportunity become American Heart Certified in each. Those who wish to become certified <u>WILL</u> have to pay for their certification cards \$10.00

CLASS IS LIMITED TO 18 STUDENTS

THE FOLLOWING ARE 2 DAY CLASSES:

8) CONFINE SPACE RESCUE:

This class will begin by covering 29 CFR 1910.146, Permit Required Confine Spaces & works its way through the equipment & procedures required to execute a rescue from a confined space. Vertical & horizontal spaces will be displayed and made available to execute rescues. THIS IS A HANDS ON CLASS <u>EQUIMENT NEEDED: gloves, hard</u> <u>hat/helmet, eye protection & steel toe shoes. NO FIRE BOOTS PERMITTED</u>

9) BASIC ROPE RESCUE:

This is an Awareness rescuer level class. Students will learn the differences between the different types of ropes & their care. Basic knots, equipment & their uses.

Equipment Needed: helmet with chin strap, clean leather gloves, not been used for firefighting or extrication, sturdy boots with ankle support (no fire boots)

10) EMT CON – ED:

This class will offer the 16 hours that are mandatory for EMT's & 1st Responders for re-certification by KBEMS. This will be a combination of lectures & hands on skills. Instructors: AIR METHODS OF KY.

11) LEADERSHIP I:

This National Fire Academy Course presents the company officer with the basic leadership skills and tools needed to perform effectively as a leader in the fire service environment. This course address techniques and approaches to problem – solving, identifying & assessing needs of their department, conducting meetings effectively, & decision – making for the company officer.

12) HAZ – MAT OPERATIONS:

This class will start SATURDAY AFTER LUNCH & finish Sunday (12 hrs. class). This course will provide to 1st Responders the information they need to take appropriate initial actions when hazardous materials spills, or releases are encountered. Its scope is limited to giving detailed information about the initial defensive operations. This class meets the Ky. Fire Commission requirements for T-0002
