#### 1) FRIDAY NIGHT 6:00 – 10:00PM METH LAB AWARENESS

This class will provide the students an overview of the meth. threat in Ky. The drug's impact will be discussed with the primary emphasis in recognition of clandestine labs & their dangers for 1<sup>st</sup> responders

#### 2) FRIDAY NIGHT 6:00 – 10:00 PM WILDLAND FIREFIGHTING AWARENESS

This course is a product of portions from the  $\,S-130\,$  (basic wildland firefighting) &  $S-190\,$  (wildland fire behavior) courses. The Kentucky Fire Commission adopted this course for basic firefighting knowledge & is MANDATORY for all new firefighters after 07/01/01. This class meets Fire Commission requirement for FC30000

#### 3) FRIDAY NIGHT 6:00 – 10:00PM CANCER AWARENESS

First time offered at Fire School. This course is for firefighters of ALL levels. This course is designed to address common practices that we can do to protect ourselves from hazards that increase exposures to carcinogens

## 4) FIREFIGHTER SURVIVAL SATURDAY ONLY

This course will emphasize removal of a trapped or unconscious firefighters from a burning building & self rescue techniques when the primary escape route is blocked. This is a required class for all NEW firefighters effective 07/01/00

## 5) FIRFIGHTER RESCUE SUNDAY ONLY

This course is designed to teach us how to rescue victims from a burning building. Special techniques are used for rescue, OSHA 2 in 2 out regulation. This is a required class set forth by Ky. Fire Commission.

## 6) INSTRUCTOR METHODOLGY SATURDAY AM

This course is designed for company officers & other fire service instructors with the responsibility of conducting training at your department. ## 7) STOP THE CYCLE OF FIREFIGHTER TURNOVER -- SATURDAY PM

## 8) UNDERSTANDING ISO SUNDAY AM

This class is being offered by ISO. It will help prepare a department for their next ISO audit & better understand what is expected of them at that audit. IF WE DON'T HAVE AT LEAST 30 PRE-REGISTERED FOR THIS CLASS ISO WILL CANCEL

## 9) INSTRUCTOR METHODOLGY SUNDAY PM

This class will START Sunday after lunch. This course is designed for company officers & other fire service instructors with the responsibility of conducting training at your department. Emphasis on teaching principles & techniques applicable to the fire service. It includes effective communication, teaching from lesson plans, with an emphasis on skills training & adult learning. #### 10) EMT CON-ED

## 11) BASIC ESSENTIALS OF FIREFIGHTING This 2 day course is for the new firefighter to get 16 hrs. of the recommended 20 hrs. from the Fire Commission, to respond to calls <u>FULL TURNOUT GEAR & S.C.B.A. ARE</u> <u>REQUIRED</u>

#### 12) CLUSTER "HARD TO GET HOURS"

This 2 day course will feature topics that are always hard to get including but not limited to: Aircraft Crash Fire Rescue, Fire Protection Systems, Victim Search & Rescue, Flashover Classroom, Emergency & Disaster Training

#### 13) ATV/UTV SAFETY & RESCUE

This 2 day class will cover topics including protective gear main ATV/UTV parts & safety features, pre ride inspection, operating safety, & riding skills on slopes & other terrain, 1<sup>st</sup> aid & rescue situations.

#### 14) ADVANCED FIRE ATTACK

This class will be 2 days of HANDS – ON training with LIVE FIRE. Students will be espoused to fighting fires at street level, below & above street level. Also being offered for the 1<sup>st</sup> time hands on live training on helicopter fires

#### 15) LEADERSHIP I

This NFA course presents the NEW company officer with basic leadership skills & tools needed to perform effectively in the fire service. This course includes techniques & approaches to problem solving.

# 16) STRATEGY and TACTICS for INITIAL COMPANY OPERATIONS (STICO) This NFA class is DESIGNED TO MEET THE NEEDS OF Company Officers responsible for managing operations for one or more companies during structure firefighting operations. STICO is designed to develop the management skills needed by company officers to accomplish assigned tactics at structure fires.

#### 17) PUMP MAINTENANCE & TESTING This course is designed to help departments, trouble shoot pump problems & issues. The importance of setting up regular maintenance schedule & yearly testing.

## 18) ARSON DETECTION FOR THE 1<sup>ST</sup> RESPONDER

The classroom delivery will cover many phases of initial fire scene investigation with emphasis on the firefighter's responsibility in arson detection
